The Cullman High Boys' Cross Country team completed another successful season this year winding up with a $6-2$ season record. The Bearcat runners did well in every tournament they entered with results including second place finishes in the Cullman Invitational and the Tennessee Valley Conference They finished first in the John Carroll Invitational, their biggest win of the year, defeating an old nemesis, Gardendale, for the first time. The team capped their ' 77 season off with a second place finish in the state tournament out of thirteen teams, as Gardendale slipped by for first.
