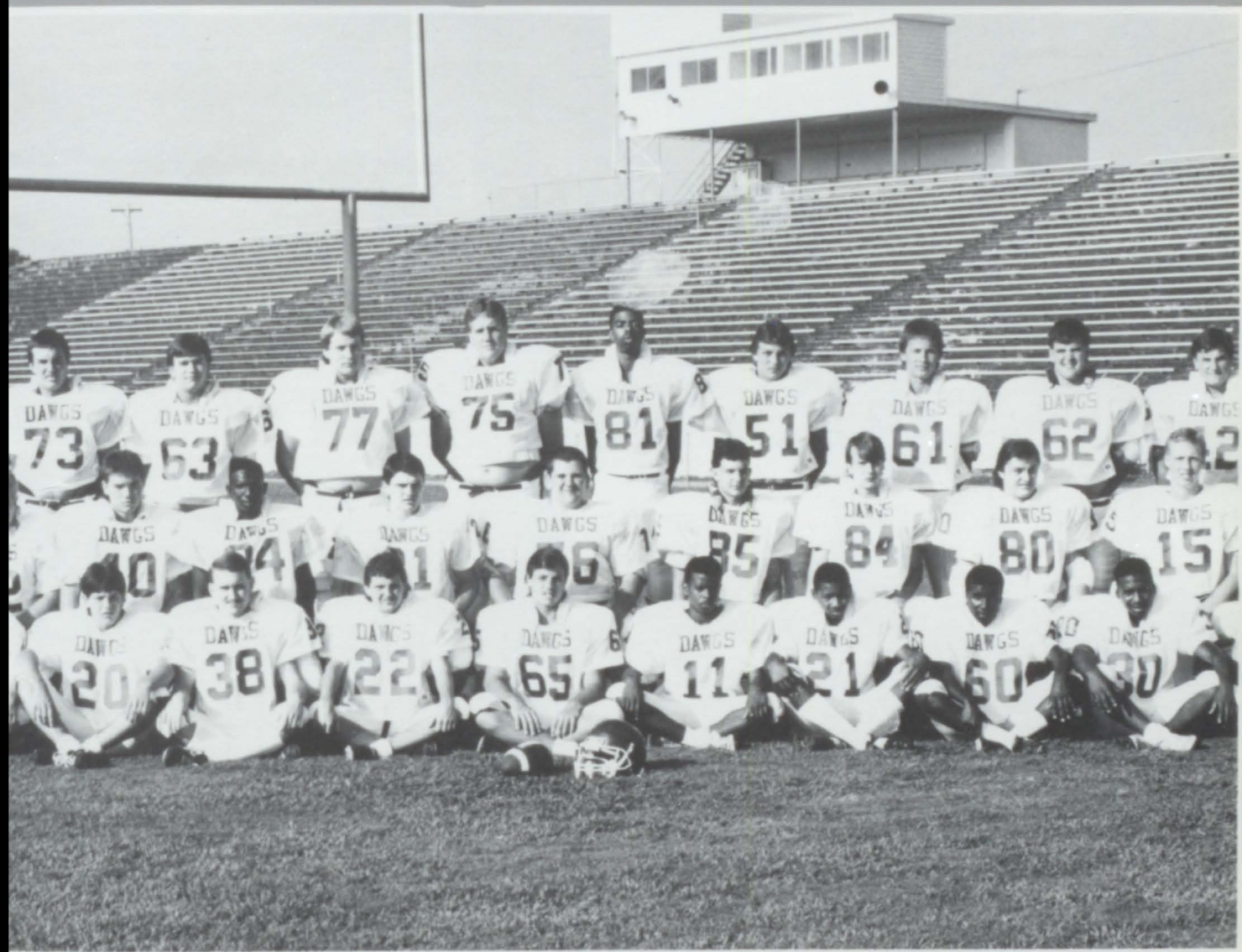
The Senior Bulldogs were a driving force of the team this season. Their experience and determination showed that their hard work had payed off.

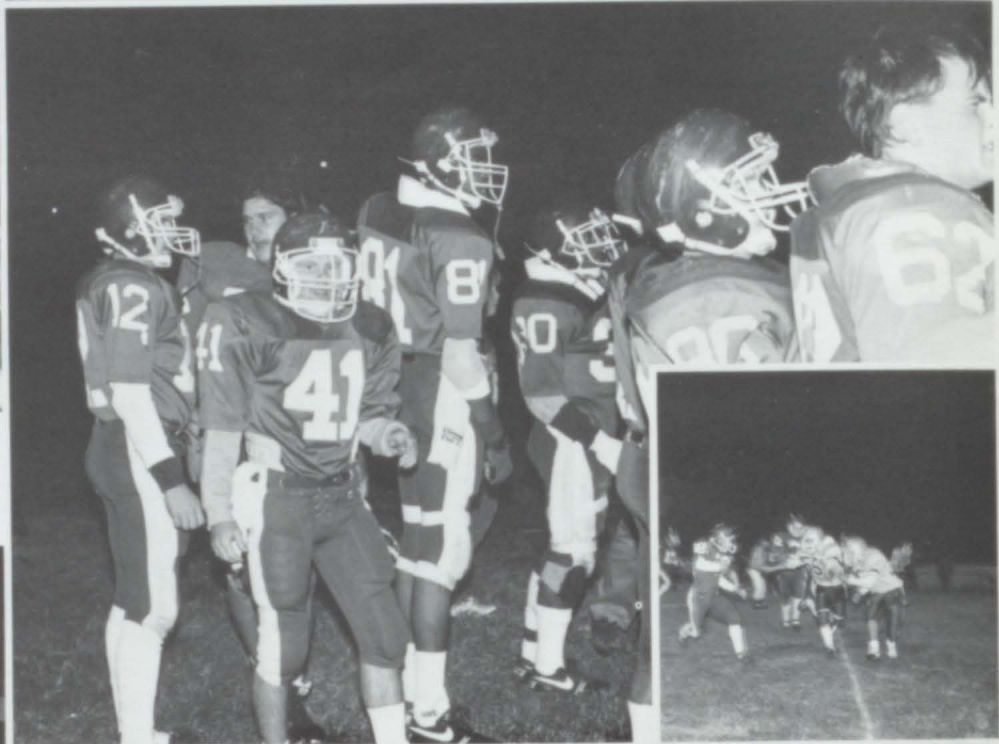
Senior tackle Rich Stimson made the All-County team this year for his second time on the varsity squad. When asked how it felt he said "It was pretty cool."

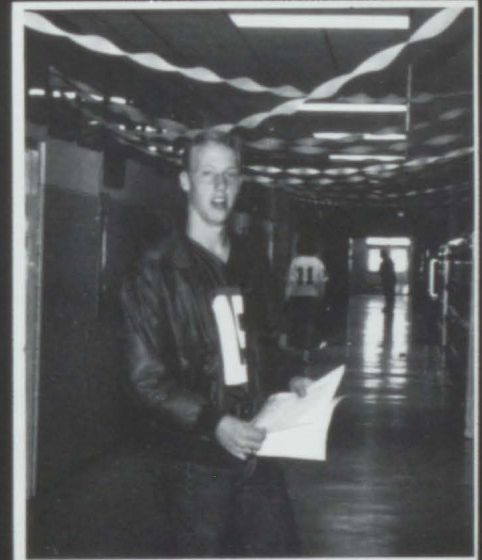
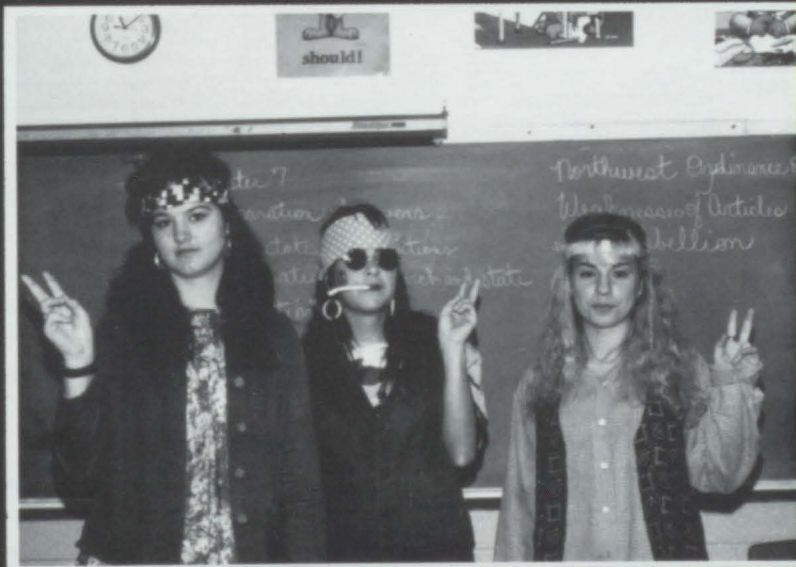

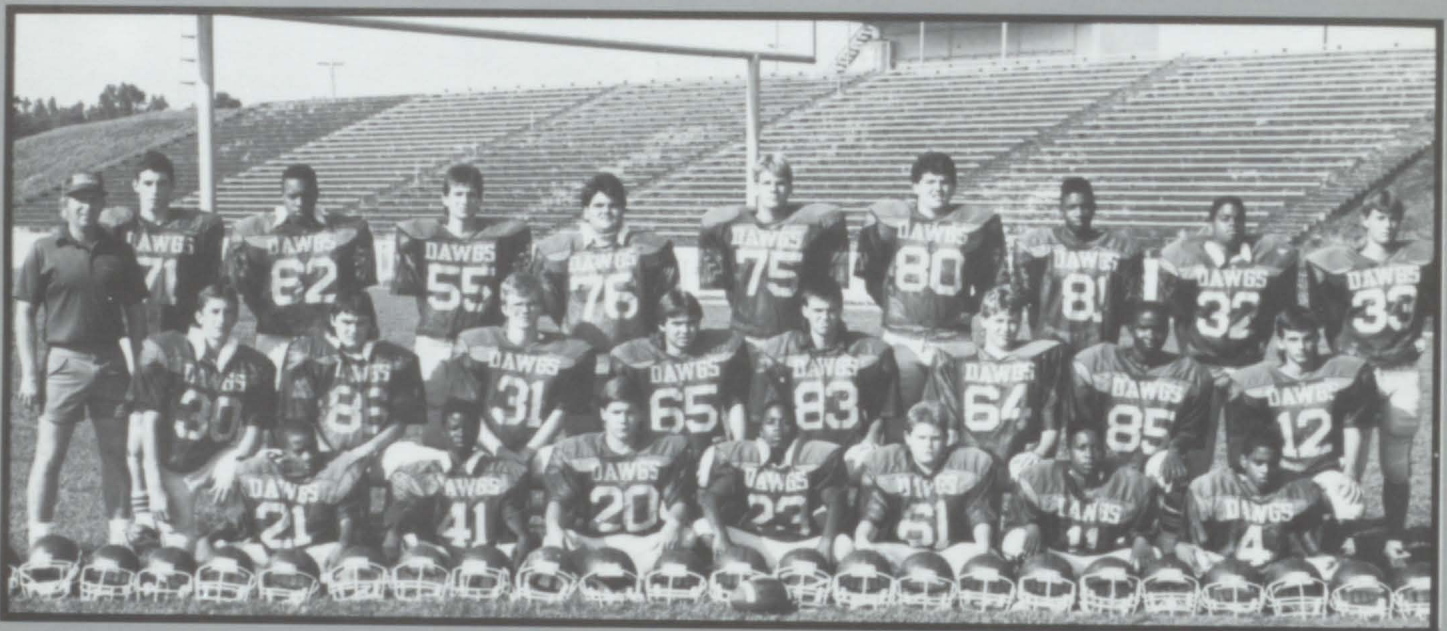

Another outstanding player was Stene Milne with 352 yards rushing, and scoring 40 points.

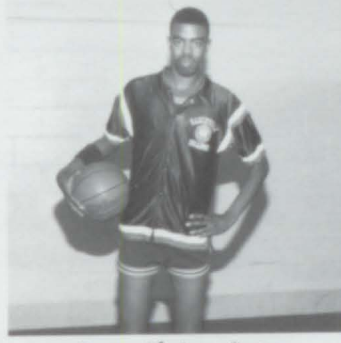
