



























# CHS

# 1986 BEARCAT FOOTBALL TEAM



#### Cullman vs. Muscle Shoals 12-0

The key to the Muscle Shoals game was the accurate and awesome defense of the Bearcats which caused seven turnovers, six of which were interceptions, three were bagged by Walker, one picked off with a brilliant return down the sidelines, cutting across the field and avoiding tackles as he raced on in for the score. Keith Drake lit up the scoreboard with the other score as he crashed in for paydirt behind the superb blocking of right guard Lance Reese, and right tackle Ronnie Mayhair.

Matt Patrick led the Cullman rushers with 75 yards on 20 attempts. Following Patrick was Keith Drake with 62 yards on 5 carries, Hydrick with 45 on 13 totes and Page with 33 on 13 snaps. Danny Ashley led the Bearcat receivers with 21 yards in one catch and Mark Dryer had 2 receptions for 17 yards.

The Cullman Bearcats posted their second shutout of the season defeating the area 14 Muscle Shoals Trojans 12-0, advancing the 'Cats to the second round of the 5A state playoffs.

#### Cullman vs. Russelville 3-0

The Bearcats struggled through three and a half quarters of play until the Bearcat offense came to life under the senior leadership of quarterback Jay Page and tailback Matt Patrick driving 78 yards in 14 plays to the Russelville 2 where senior Ronnie Mayhair kicked the winning field goal.

The Cullman Bearcat defense led by David Jones, Jeff Hydrick, Patrick Knight, Andy Starnes, Shannon Christian, Tim Pack, Danny Ashley, Shonn Walker, Keith Drake, Lance Reese, Chris Michelfelder and a few others was again the savior as it buckled down and stopped the Golden Tigers every time it neared the Bearcat goal line, to post its second consecutive playoff shutout, by fumble recoveries by Shannon Christian and then Andy Starnes. David Jones sealed the victory when he intercepted a pass as the clock ran down.

Matt Patrick was the leading rusher with 46 yards on 15 carries. Jay Page followed with 42 yards on 15 tries and Jeff Hydrick picked up 26 yards on 6 attempts. Patrick Knight led the receivers with 47 yards on 2 catches.

This win over Russelville put the Bearcats up against Gadsden on their home field in the quarter finals of the 5A state playoffs.

#### Cullman vs. Gadsden 14-9

The Bearcats' quest for a 5A state championship ended at Murphee Stadium against the Gadsden Tigers.

Cullman played solid football on both sides of the ball, but just couldn't bring home the victory. The 'Cats generated 211 yards of offense and only gave up 207 yards on defense. However, it was turnovers that cost Cullman the game. The Bearcats had four turnovers — two of which were converted into touchdowns by Gadsden.

Matt Patrick led all Bearcat rushers with 56 yards on 14 attempts. Following Patrick was Jay Page with 20 yards on 10 carries and Drake with 15 yards on 4 totes. Shonn Walker and Danny Ashley were the leading receivers for Cullman. Walker had 68 yards on 7 catches and Ashley had 53 yards on 2 snags.
