

























Bits of a Day

Bits of Changes This Year

Inflation hit the lunchroom. The price for a standard meal jumped from \$1.15 to \$1.25. For thirty cents a student could purchase either a cup of tea or the cup without the tea.

New classes including advanced placement chemistry for seniors, advanced algebra II and advanced geometry for math team members, and electives in wildlife, animal science, and horticulture were added. The range of after school activities was broadened to include a swim team and Leo, a service club open to all students.

Southtrust Bank, our school sponsor, began

issuing V.I.P. cards to students who made straight A's or had perfect attendance for the semester. By showing his card a student could obtain discounts for one semester at stores owned by local merchants.

The computer age struck Cullman High School. New computers in the office were used to schedule classes, record absences, store grades, rank students, and print report cards. Each new report card was a single sheet of paper with spaces not only for grades, but also for small comments such as highly motivated, satisfactory

progress, or conference requested.

Like all new things a few complaints followed. Schedules were not available until open house on Sunday afternoon. Seniors were disgusted to discover that their grade point averages and ranks were not available until the second six weeks. Students thought the report card comments were rather impersonal and worse than no comment. Despite these few problems our school has entered the computer age — an age in which there is no one to blame except the computer.
