



# HOMECOMING 1996: A WORLD OF CHANGE




# MR AND MISS CHS

# Season Summary

## 1995 Lady Bearcats' Softball

The spring of 1995 brought new enthusiasm to the girls' softball program in the form of a new head coach, Brownie Price. Coach Price, was ably assisted by Norman Adams, Mike Callan, and Rickey Crumbley. Stacie Wren served as team sponsor. About 60 girls signed up for tryouts and from this number 30 were chosen to represent Cullman High as varsity players. All the players returned from a good 1994 team except one graduating senior, Emily Price. A strong tournament experienced group of 9th graders added to the wealth of returning talent. In order to provide an adequate experience for this large group, a heavy schedule was worked up. There would be no Junior Varsity team this year and all games would be considered varsity. Early in the season the philosophy was to dress out 15-18 girls for a double header and then another 15-18 girls for the next double header. In doing this all the girls could gain valuable playing experience while developing their skills. As the season wound down, the top 15 or so players were chosen to play, based on their earlier performance, in order to be ready for the state playoffs. In all the team played 78 games, winning 48 and losing 30. After the best combination of players were picked at the end of the season, the team won 18 of its last 21 games, and went on to place 3rd in the State Championship Tournament. Congratulations! Other than the 1991 State Champions this is the best finish ever of any Cullman High girls softball team.

## 1996 IN PERSPECTIVE

Regardless of how well a team does, if it doesn't meet its own expectations or the expectations of its fans or coaches, there is disappointment. Such was the case in 1996. This was a team that had lost 4 seniors, 3 of which were starters, and had placed 3rd in the STATE the previous year. It not only expected to go to the STATE (the final 8) again, but also to be there at the end with a chance to win it all. It didn't happen. Regardless of a team's record or its talent or athletic skill, in order to make it to STATE, it must play to its capabilities on the day of Sectionals and on the day of Sub-State, otherwise its season is over. On May 4, 1996, in Sectionals, Cullman lost to Athens 7-13 and then to Fayette County 4-7. These were two teams that Cullman had already beaten earlier in the season, and most observers would have favored Cullman to beat them again. It didn't happen. That's why we play the game on the field and not from an armchair.

In all the rhetoric and disappointment, one should not lose sight of the fact that this was truly a great team and an extremely gifted group of girls. Its accomplishments may have been overlooked, even by the girls themselves, because of their disappointment. This was a team that beat 8 different teams that ended the season ranked 5th in the STATE or higher in their respective classifications. This was a Cullman team that was explosive offensively and capable of scoring runs in bunches and embarrassing good or even great teams. This team averaged over 11 runs per game in a 45 game season.

As Annie says in the musical, "The sun will come up tomorrow." You can "bet your bottom dollar" that Cullman will be back in 1997. The future looks bright for the Lady Bearcats in 1997, with a new head coach, Coach Matt Scott, with all the team returning except Sheri Mayo, and with some very good freshman prospects. Then maybe ... just maybe ... 1997 is the year of the Lady Bearcats!
